HOUSE BILL HB2132

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; mandating insurance carriers issuing motor vehicle liability policies provide certain discounts to certain teachers under certain conditions; specifying such conditions; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7-601.3 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Beginning January 1, 2001, every insurance carrier issuing vehicle liability policies shall provide a discount to the teachers who meet all of the following criteria:

1. Those teachers who have a good driving record as determined by the Department of Public Safety;
2. Those teachers who have obtained bus driver training and a commercial driver license; and
3. Those teachers who have contracted to drive a bus for the school district and substitute drive a bus regularly.

B. Those teachers who have been without violations or accidents for at least four (4) years shall receive a ten percent (10%) discount and those teachers who have been without violations or accidents for at least eight (8) years shall receive a fifteen-percent discount.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2001.
