HOUSE BILL HB2446

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating the Sam Fields Memorial Highway; requiring the Department of Transportation to place markers; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1637 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

State Highway 127, starting at the intersection of State Highway 127 and State Highway 20 near Jay extending approximately thirteen (13.0) miles to the intersection of State Highway 127 and State Highway 10, shall be designated as the "Sam Fields Memorial Highway". The Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing the name.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2000.
