AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to tourism; authorizing the leasing of certain properties of the Great Salt Plains State Park; providing for the deposit of certain monies; stating purpose; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1850.2 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Property of the Great Salt Plains State Park without improvements may be leased to a private enterprise in accordance with the rules of the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission. All monies derived from the lease shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department Revolving Fund. The purpose of such lease shall be to improve the usage and attractiveness of the entire Great Salt Plains State Park.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1999.
