HOUSE BILL NO. 1142

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 85.39, as amended by Section 9, Chapter 371, O.S.L. 1998 (74 O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 85.39), which relates to purchasing procedures of state agencies; and clarifying language.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 85.39, as amended by Section 9, Chapter 371, O.S.L. 1998 (74 O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 85.39), is amended to read as follows:

Section 85.39 A. 1. Each state agency shall develop internal purchasing procedures for all acquisitions including, but not limited to, needs assessment, funding, routing, review, audits, monitoring and evaluations and submit the procedures to the State Purchasing Director.

2. For acquisition procedures subject to the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act, state agencies shall submit a copy of the procedures within ten (10) days of development.

3. The State Purchasing Director shall review the procedures submitted pursuant to paragraph 2 of this subsection to determine whether they comply with the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act, rules promulgated pursuant thereto, and Sections 3001 through 3010 of this title. The State Purchasing Director shall provide written findings, including details of noncompliance, if any, to the Director of the Department of Central Services, who shall notify the state agency within fifteen (15) days after the procedures are

submitted and indicate revisions necessary to bring the procedures into compliance.

B. Prior to a state agency making acquisitions over the twenty-five-hundred-dollar limit pursuant to Section 4 85.5 of this ~~act~~ title, the state agency shall comply with this section.

C. Each state agency shall maintain a document file for each contract which shall include, at a minimum, justification for the contract, supporting documentation and related information, copies of the contract, evaluations, written reports if required by the contract, and other such information as is required by the State Purchasing Director.

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
