AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to mental health; amending 43A O.S. 1991, Section 2-108, which relates to investigations by the Board of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services; clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 1991, Section 2-108, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2-108. When the Board of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services has reason to believe that any person alleged or adjudged to be mentally ill is wrongfully deprived of ~~his~~ liberty, or is cruelly, negligently or improperly treated, or inadequate provision is made for ~~his~~ skillful medical care, proper supervision and safe keeping of that person, the Commissioner may ascertain the facts or may order an investigation of the facts for the Board.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1999.
