AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public buildings and public works; setting forth exemption from Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974 for certain demolition and removal; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 103.4 of Title 61, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

For purposes of the provisions of the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974, contracts solely for right-of-way clearance by the Oklahoma Transportation Commission and the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority for the exclusive purpose of demolition and removal of buildings, foundations, slab floors, stem walls, steps, brush, shrubs, brickbats or stone and all rubbish, scrap iron, fencing, and debris, and the installation of new right-of-way fencing, shall not be considered to be public construction contracts and shall not be required to be open for competitive bidding.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1999.
