AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution directing the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to continue serving eligible persons participating in certain program services across the state; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Legislature proudly recognizes the importance of the human service and health care delivery systems which provide a vast number of needed programs to many of our citizens in this state; and

WHEREAS, members of the Oklahoma Legislature have throughout the years supported various health- and human-service-related initiatives which have ultimately enhanced the lives of thousands of Oklahomans, including people with disabling conditions, older persons, and others who are unable to care for themselves; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary, even in times of tight budgetary constraints, to maintain high levels of adequate programs to enhance the lives of citizens who may be utilizing these types of program services across the state.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to continue serving eligible disabled persons, older persons and others who are unable to provide for themselves who are participating in the existing various human and health services programs across the state regardless of budgetary constraints.

THAT a copy of this resolution be sent to the Honorable Governor, Frank Keating; the Chief Executive Officer of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority, Mike Fogarty; and the Director of the Oklahoma Department of Human Services, Howard Hendrick.
