AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution congratulating the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission on being named the National Liquor Law Enforcement Association Agency of the Year; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission, previously known as the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, is a constitutional board established in 1959 to regulate the liquor industry in Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission currently regulates and licenses charity gaming, enforces provisions of the Prevention of Youth Access to Tobacco Act, and continues to regulate all aspects of the liquor industry in the State of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission has a long and exemplary record of outstanding service and dedication to performing its statutory duties, as well as a commitment to performing above and beyond those duties to assist the citizens of Oklahoma during times of emergency; and

WHEREAS, for these and other reasons the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission was selected by the National Liquor Law Enforcement Association as the Liquor Law Enforcement Agency of the Year for 1999.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
CONCURRING THEREIN:
