AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution memorializing the public service of Thomas J. Manar; designating bridge on U.S. Highway 281 the "Tom Manar Memorial Bridge"; directing Oklahoma Department of Transportation to place permanent markers; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Representative Tom Manar was a dedicated public servant and champion of the people; and

WHEREAS, Tom Manar cared deeply for the people of his community and of this state and always strived to make Oklahoma a better place for the citizenry; and

WHEREAS, Tom Manar will forever be remembered as a man who stood firm in his convictions and never shirked any duty or responsibility or avoided controversial issues that needed to be addressed; and

WHEREAS, Tom Manar was firmly grounded and provided a bridge between the Legislature and the community he served.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the bridge over East Cache Creek located 2.5 miles north of the Comanche county line on U.S. 281 be dedicated as the "Tom Manar Memorial Bridge".

THAT the Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall cause permanent suitable markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing the name.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to Neal McCaleb,
Secretary and Director of Transportation, to the members of the
State Transportation Commission, and to the family of Tom Manar.
