RESOLUTION HJR1062

AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution relating to finally adopted rules of the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture; disapproving amendments to permanent rules OAC 35:30-17-1, OAC 35:30-17-6, OAC 35:30-17-32, OAC 35:30-17-54, OAC 35:30-17-66, and OAC 35:30-17-69, relating to pesticides, license categories, recertification, cut-off dates, minimum standards for termite work, ground treatment under buildings and concrete slabs, and finally adopted permanent rules OAC 35:30-17-21, and OAC 35:30-17-28, relating to records required for pesticide application and restricted use pesticide sales, and soil residue levels; providing for distribution; and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 250.2 and 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature reserves the right to designate the method for rule promulgation, establish policy, determine that a rule is not consistent with legislative intent and disapprove any rule or any portion thereof at any time; and

WHEREAS, on May 15, 2000, the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture finally adopted amendments to permanent rules OAC 35:30-17-1, OAC 35:30-17-6, OAC 35:30-17-32, OAC 35:30-17-54, OAC 35:30-17-66, and OAC 35:30-17-69, relating to pesticides, license categories, recertification, cut-off dates, minimum standards for termite work, ground treatment under buildings and concrete slabs, and finally adopted permanent rules OAC 35:30-17-21, and OAC 35:30-17-28, relating to records required for pesticide application and restricted use pesticide sales, and soil residue levels; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes that the finally adopted amendments to permanent rules and finally adopted permanent rules

are not consistent with legislative intent, and violate public policy.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 2nd SESSION OF THE 47th OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Legislature hereby disapproves finally adopted amendments to permanent rules OAC 35:30-17-1, OAC 35:30-17-6, OAC 35:30-17-32, OAC 35:30-17-54, OAC 35:30-17-66, and OAC 35:30-17-69, and finally adopted permanent rules OAC 35:30-17-21, and OAC 35:30-17-28.

SECTION 2. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to distribute copies of this resolution to the Governor, the members of the Oklahoma State Board of Agriculture and the Editor of "The Oklahoma Register".

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
