AS INTRODUCED

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma House of Representatives has traditionally shown support for those who have made great sacrifices in serving their country and state.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives, in the name of the people of this great state, on this commemorative day, June 25, 2000, wishes to honor and thank these courageous veterans and their

families, especially the families who lost loved ones in that conflict.

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives also honors the multitude of other veterans who so courageously served their state and nation in all other wars and conflicts, past and present, and honors these brave people on Thanksgiving Day 2000, the first Thanksgiving in the new millennium and a day of great thankfulness for their combat service.
