AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution honoring Charles H. Brown upon the occasion of his retirement as Head Football Coach at Holland Hall School in Tulsa, Oklahoma; wishing him well in future endeavors; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Charlie Brown, a graduate of Crescent High School, Crescent, Oklahoma, earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Natural Science from Central State Teachers College, and a Masters Degree in Natural Science from the University of Oklahoma, and attended the National Science Foundation Physics and AP Chemistry Institutes; and

WHEREAS, Charlie Brown served as a teacher of Science and Chemistry and Varsity Coach for Casady School in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, Charlie Brown continued his 35-year career in education at Holland Hall School in Tulsa, Oklahoma, as an instructor in Physics, Chemistry, Varsity Football and Baseball Coach, Athletic Director, Dean of Students Upper School, Director for Summer Projects and Programs; and

WHEREAS, Charlie Brown through his coaching efforts led school teams to four SPC Baseball Championships, seven concurrent SPC Football Championships, holds the record for the longest winning streak of 21 games for any Tulsa High School, and has a Football Coaching record of 199-124-5; and

WHEREAS, Charlie Brown has shown civic concern throughout his career as an Elder at Southminster Presbyterian Church, and holding

offices of President and Secretary-Treasurer for the Southwest Preparatory Conference; and

WHEREAS, Charlie Brown has received many education and civic honors and awards, including six National Science Foundation Grants in Chemistry, Physics and Mathematics, being named Coach of the Week by the Tulsa World Sports, and inducted into the Oklahoma Coaches Hall of Fame.
