AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution encouraging the United States Air Force to locate the Global Hawk mission at Tinker Air Force Base.

WHEREAS, the United States Air Force is implementing a mission for unmanned aircraft, known as Global Hawk; and

WHEREAS, the Global Hawk is a complete aerial reconnaissance system which provides accurate, up-to-date intelligence information for mission safety and effectiveness in peacekeeping and combat operations, with such vehicles operating at an altitude of approximately 60,000 feet; and

WHEREAS, the United States Air Force is seeking a location for the Global Hawk mission; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma's own Tinker Air Force Base is one of the sites being considered for the location of the Global Hawk mission; and

WHEREAS, this state has a long and unbroken history of strong support for the United States Air Force, including the various missions located at Tinker Air Force Base; and

WHEREAS, the personnel at Tinker Air Force Base are second to none in terms of their quality, enthusiasm, and teamwork; and

WHEREAS, this state wishes to show its support for the United States Air Force, Tinker Air Force Base, and the Global Hawk mission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature wholeheartedly encourages the United States Air Force to locate the Global Hawk mission at Tinker Air Force Base and welcomes the opportunity to show once again that Oklahoma is proud to support the United States Air Force.
