AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution honoring and congratulating the El Reno Indians Wrestling Team and their Coaches for their fourth straight dual and individual Class 4A State Title and the State Academic Title; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the El Reno Indians Wrestling Team recently captured their fourth straight dual and individual Class 4A State Title and the State Academic Title for the second year in a row, once again bringing home the trophies to El Reno High School; and

WHEREAS, the El Reno Indians Wrestling Team is the first school to win four consecutive titles in the 11-year history of the dual state championships; and

WHEREAS, in the team's four-year championship run, the Indians have crowned 19 individual state champions, five in each of the last three seasons; and

WHEREAS, the El Reno Indians Wrestling Team won its eighth athletic state championship overall; and

WHEREAS, the team excelled under the able and professional leadership of Head Coach Archie Randall and Assistant Coaches Mitch Brown, Pat Liticker and Jeff Little; and

WHEREAS, not only did the team learn the value of hard work, dedication, perseverance and pride, but the importance of education,

all of which helped them overcome many obstacles on their drive to the championship; and

WHEREAS, the members of the House of Representatives and the Oklahoma Senate wish to recognize the accomplishments of these outstanding student-athletes, the El Reno Indians Wrestling Team, and their leaders, Head Coach Archie Randall and Assistant Coaches Mitch Brown, Pat Liticker and Jeff Little.
