AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution congratulating Bartlesville, Oklahoma, for winning the Disney prize parade contest; recognizing the work of Beth Cook, Ron Lewis, Barbara Eck and Richard Kane Elementary School; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Bartlesville, Oklahoma, recently won a Disney parade for July 3, 1999, for being the town which most creatively conveyed how its community represents Mickey Mouse's enthusiasm and can-do spirit; and

WHEREAS, Bartlesville, Oklahoma, was one of 130,000 entries in the contest representing all of the United States; and

WHEREAS, Richard Kane Elementary school, headed by principal Beth Cook, won the contest by having about 500 students, 63 faculty members and 40 parents create a "Bartlesville Loves Mickey" human formation on a football field and having this formation which was designed by Ron Lewis photographed from the air; and

WHEREAS, along with letters and pictures sent by the students, this aerial photograph by local pilot Barbara Eck, won the contest for Bartlesville.
