AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution relating to the House Rules; amending Section 4 of House Rule 22 of the 47th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to conference committee reports; and adding requirements for consideration of measures for which a conference committee report has been adopted.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 4 of House Rule 22 of the 47th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

RULE 22

GENERAL PROCEDURES

Section 4: Conference Committee Reports.

~~(a) All conference committee reports shall be reproduced for distribution before consideration, except where the title only is altered and time will not permit the printing prior to the close of a legislative session.~~

~~(b)~~ A motion to adopt or reject a conference committee report shall be subject to debate. Such debate shall be limited to one (1) hour, equally divided between the proponents and the opponents of the motion.

~~(c)~~ (b) Prior to consideration, a conference committee report shall lie over twenty-four (24) hours after it is filed. This subsection shall not apply on the last two (2) days of any legislative session once the date of the sine die adjournment has been set.

(c) No measure for which a conference committee report has been adopted shall be considered unless each and every word of the measure has been recited orally from beginning to end before the House or every member of the House has been provided access to a printed copy or access to the measure electronically.
