SENATE BILL 1001

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state employees; providing intent; authorizing state agencies to establish employee recognition and incentive programs; authorizing expenditures for recognition awards; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-7.1 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

It is the intent of the Legislature that the promotion of excellence in the workplace is a legitimate public purpose. In order to establish a state government quality program, state agencies are hereby authorized to establish employee recognition and incentive programs. In order to promote excellence in state government, state agencies are authorized to expend state appropriated monies for employee recognition ceremonies and the purchase of recognition awards for presentation to members of work units or individual employees.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
