SENATE BILL 1014

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission; amending 37 O.S. 1991, Section 570, which relates to qualifications of certain personnel; deleting peace officer requirement for obsolete personnel category; establishing age and education requirements for agents appointed after certain date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 37 O.S. 1991, Section 570, is amended to read as follows:

Section 570. A. Persons employed as chief enforcement officer, and agents, ~~and inspectors~~ of the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission shall meet the qualifications for permanent appointment as police or peace officers as provided for in Section 3311 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

B. Agents appointed after June 30, 2000, shall be at least twenty-one (21) years of age at time of appointment and shall have a bachelor's degree from a college or university accredited by an accrediting organization recognized by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
