SENATE BILL 1017

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to mental health; providing reimbursement of expenses in transporting persons for mental health services; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-111 of Title 43A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Municipalities shall be entitled to reimbursement from the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services for transportation services associated with persons requiring mental health treatment, examination, emergency detention, protective custody, and inpatient services. Any transportation provided by a municipality to or from any facility for the purpose of examination, admission, interfacility transfer, discharge, medical treatment, court appearance, mental health service, or placement of a person shall be reimbursed for each mile actually traveled at the rate established in the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2000.
