SENATE BILL 1107

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to game and fish; amending 29 O.S. 1991, Section 5-409, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 48, O.S.L. 1995 (29 O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 5-409), which relates to squirrels; clarifying statutory reference; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 1991, Section 5-409, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 48, O.S.L. 1995 (29 O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 5-409), is amended to read as follows:

Section 5-409. A. Except as otherwise provided by law, no person may capture or kill squirrels except between May 15 to January 31, both dates inclusive, nor shall such person bag or possess more than two (2) ~~day's~~ days' limit after the second day's hunt. Bag limits shall be set by the Wildlife Conservation Commission.

B. No person may cut down or remove a tree being used as a den or nest by squirrels unless specific permission for such cutting or removal has been given by the owner or lessee of the land.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2000.
