SENATE BILL 1315

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Pharmacy Act; amending Section 20, Chapter 199, O.S.L. 1993 (59 O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 353.29), which relates to use of supportive personnel; setting limits on ratio of pharmacy technicians per on-duty pharmacist under certain circumstances; defining term; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 20, Chapter 199, O.S.L. 1993 (59 O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 353.29), is amended to read as follows:

Section 353.29 The use of supportive personnel in the practice of pharmacy shall be acceptable within rules ~~and regulations~~ established by the Board; provided, a ratio of as many as, but not more than, four pharmacy technicians per on-duty pharmacist operating in any outpatient, mail-order, or institutional pharmacy shall be maintained. For the purposes of this section, "pharmacy technician" shall not include pharmacy interns or externs or other ancillary persons who may be present in the pharmacy, including, but not limited to, clerks, secretaries, cashiers, or delivery persons.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
