SENATE BILL 1400

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation; directing the Bureau to develop a plan for a career criminal and extended surveillance unit; directing distribution of certain plan to certain officials by certain date; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation shall develop a plan detailing the feasibility of establishing a Career Criminal and Extended Surveillance Unit within the agency that would be responsible for targeting, identifying, and providing information for the prosecution of career criminals. A copy of the proposed plan shall be distributed to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives on or before November 30, 2000.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2000.
