SENATE BILL 1477

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to workers' compensation; directing Judiciary Committees of Senate and House of Representatives to undertake joint study on conversion of Workers' Compensation Court; providing for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

The Judiciary Committees of the Oklahoma State Senate and House of Representatives are hereby directed to undertake a joint study on the conversion of the Workers' Compensation Court to an administrative agency or the conversion of the processes and procedures of the Workers' Compensation Court to an administrative procedure.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
