SENATE BILL 1512

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to guardian and ward; amending 30 O.S. 1991, Sections 1-105 and 1-107, which relate to the Oklahoma Guardianship and Conservatorship Act; modifying definitions of guardian and ward to allow attorney-in-fact to exercise the powers of a guardian; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 30 O.S. 1991, Section 1-105, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-105. A guardian or attorney-in-fact, pursuant to a durable power of attorney, is a person appointed by the court to take care of the person or property of another.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 30 O.S. 1991, Section 1-107, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-107. A person over whom a guardian is appointed ~~and,~~ a person over whose property a guardian or conservator is appointed, and a person who has granted authority to an attorney-in-fact, pursuant to a durable power of attorney, is called a ward.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2000.
