SENATE BILL 1536

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to protection of labor; authorizing administrative fines for employers who violate certain statutory provisions on two or more occasions within any six-month period; explaining term; providing for deposit of fines to revolving fund; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 165.2a of Title 40, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Commissioner of Labor or the Commissioner's designee is hereby authorized to assess an administrative fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) against an employer operating in this state who is found in violation of Section 165.1, et seq., of Title 40 of the Oklahoma Statutes on two or more occasions within any six-month period. For the purposes of this section, all violations arising during any single pay period shall be regarded as one occasion. All fines collected pursuant to this section shall be deposited to the Department of Labor Revolving Fund.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
