6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to jails; amending 57 O.S. 1991,
8 Section 38, as last amended by Section 76, Chapter
9 133, O.S.L. 1997 (57 O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 38),
10 which relates to jail reimbursement fee; modifying
11 reimbursement rate to the county sheriff who retains
12 an inmate; setting formula for computing the average
13 daily rate for reimbursement; providing for deposit
14 into the Sheriff's Fee Account; deleting obsolete
15 language; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 209. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 1991, Section 38, as
18 last amended by Section 76, Chapter 133, O.S.L. 1997 (57 O.S. Supp.
19 1998, Section 38), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 38. ~~A.~~ The Department of Corrections shall reimburse
21 any county, ~~which~~ sheriff who is required to retain an inmate
22 ~~pursuant to paragraph 2 of Section 37 of this title,~~ in an amount
23 ~~not to exceed Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) per day~~ equal to seventy-
24 five percent (75%) of the average daily rate paid to a private
25 prison contractor, as established by the State Board of Corrections,
26 for each inmate during such period of retention. The proceeds of
27 this reimbursement shall be deposited into the Sheriff's Fee Account
28 and used to defray expenses of equipping and maintaining the jail
29 and payment of personnel. The Department of Corrections shall
30 reimburse the county for the actual costs paid for any emergency
31 medical care for physical injury or illness of the inmate retained
32 under this resolution if the injury or illness is directly related
to the incarceration and the county is required by law to provide

1 such care for inmates in the jail. The Director may accept any
2 inmate required to have extended medical care upon application of
3 the county.

4 ~~B. The state shall provide funding for county jail~~
5 ~~incarceration for eligible felony offenders pursuant to the~~
6 ~~provisions of the Oklahoma Community Sentencing Act at a rate of~~
7 ~~Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per day per person imprisoned for a maximum~~
8 ~~term as specified in this act.~~

9 SECTION 1. This act shall become effective November 1, 1999.
