AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to tourism and recreation; granting hazardous duty pay for park rangers; stating purpose; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1811.9 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Effective July 1, 1999, the salaries for positions of Park Ranger I, II, and III shall be increased by twenty-seven and two tenths percent (27.2%). This amount is made to compensate such employees for hazardous duty. Current employees in the positions of Park Ranger I, II, and III shall receive this increase to compensation beginning July 1, 1999.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1999.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
