AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state employees; creating salary increase for certain state employees over a two-year period; setting cap on salary increase; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-2.17a of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Effective January 1, 2000, all full-time and part-time officers and employees, including temporary and other limited-term employees, of the state who were employed by the state on the last working day of December 1999, shall be awarded an annualized salary increase equal to five percent (5.0%) of their annual salary, as of December 31, 1999, after any other adjustments are made, but in no case shall the salary increase be less than One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) nor more than Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00). Such salary adjustment shall be repeated January 1, 2001, for all full-time and part-time officers and employees, including temporary and other limited-term employees, of the state who were employed by the state on the last working day of December 2000.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2000.
