AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Alarm Industry Act; amending 59 O.S. 1991, Section 1800.7, which relates to qualifications of applicants for licensing; deleting certain qualification; restricting applicability of certain qualification to certain period of time; limiting qualifications that may be applied to individual licensing; clarifying references; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 500. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 1991, Section 1800.7, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1800.7 A. Any person applying for a license to engage in an alarm industry business pursuant to the Alarm Industry Act shall provide evidence to the ~~Committee~~ Alarm Industry Committee that the individual within this state having direct supervision over the function and local operations of such alarm industry business or a branch thereof has the following qualifications:

1. Is at least twenty-one (21) years of age;
2. Has not been declared by any court of competent jurisdiction incompetent by reason of mental defect or disease, and has not been restored to competency;
3. Is not a habitual user of intoxicating liquors or habit-forming drugs;
4. ~~Has not been discharged from the Armed Services of the United States under other than honorable conditions;~~
5. Is of good moral character; and

~~6.~~ 5. Meets such other standards as may be established by the ~~Board~~ State Board of Health relating to experience or knowledge of the alarm industry.

B. The applicant shall advise the Committee and furnish full information on each individual described in subsection A of this section of any conviction within the previous ten (10) years of a felony or any crime involving moral turpitude for which a full pardon has not been granted and furnish a recent photograph of a type prescribed by the Board and two classifiable sets of fingerprints of such individual.

C. Qualifications for licensing of an applicant employed by, or to be employed by, an alarm industry business shall not exceed or be more stringent than the qualifications set forth in this section for a license to engage in an alarm industry business.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
