AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety; amending 63 O.S. 1991, Section 1-1525, which relates to the Smoking in Public Places Act; clarifying statutory reference; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 1991, Section 1-1525, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-1525. The state or local governmental agency or the person who owns or operates a public place shall, at a minimum, do the following in order to prevent smoking in nonsmoking areas:

1. Post signs which state that smoking in that public place is prohibited in designated nonsmoking areas, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1-1521 et seq. of this act title; and

2. Ask smokers to refrain from smoking upon request of a client or employee suffering discomfort from the smoke or who has hypersensitivity to smoke.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1999.
