AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to county jails; allowing detention officers who have completed training to carry chemical sprays, stun guns or other non-lethal devices on their person while on duty inside of the jail facility; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 54.1 of Title 57, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of OAC 310:670-5-2, a sheriff may authorize detention officers, who have completed training in their use, to carry chemical sprays, stun guns or other non-lethal devices on their person in the commission of their duties inside of the jail facility.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1999.
