AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to capital improvement; authorizing expenditure of certain sum for certain purposes; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. From monies available in the Capital Improvement Revolving Fund the Department of Central Services is hereby authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) for the purpose of site location, design and architectural work as approved by the Long-Range Capital Planning Commission and the Contingency Review Board.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2000.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
