AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution encouraging the State Department of Health to expand availability of Eldercare and emergency medical services to all counties in the state; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Eldercare Program in Oklahoma currently operates in seventy-one of seventy-seven counties in this state; and

WHEREAS, the Eldercare Program is intended to assist vulnerable elderly individuals to remain in their homes and maintain their independence for as long as possible; and

WHEREAS, many of Oklahoma's vulnerable elderly live alone and this number will increase in coming years; and

WHEREAS, vulnerable elderly citizens who live alone fear being unable to help themselves in a medical emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the State Department of Health is hereby encouraged to expand the availability of Eldercare and Emergency Medical Services in all counties in the State of Oklahoma.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the State Commissioner of Health.
