AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution commending Linda L. Batty for her contributions to public education; wishing her well in her future endeavors in the private sector; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Linda L. Batty graduated from Central State College with a Bachelor of Arts in Education with a major in English and minor in German. She received her Masters of Education in Secondary English from Georgia State University; and

WHEREAS, Linda L. Batty taught eighth- and ninth-grade English in Albuquerque, New Mexico; seventh- and-eighth grade English in Galveston, Texas; seventh- and eighth-grade English in Douglas County, Georgia; and ninth-grade Honors English in Roanoke County, Virginia. Since 1977, Linda L. Batty has taught Honors English, Gifted/Talented, Psychology, Web Page, Humanities and College Prep at the public schools in Claremore, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, Linda L. Batty participated in the British/American Teacher Exchange Program; served as President of the Claremore Classroom Teachers' Association; served as Oklahoma Odyssey of the Mind State Board Member; was a Mentor in the University of Tulsa Summer Program for Native American High School Students; served as a member of the Claremore Public Schools Technology Committee and the Gifted Education Local Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, Linda L. Batty was selected as Claremore Teacher of the Year in 1982; received the Oklahoma Regional Citizen Bee Award in

1989; named Will Rogers Junior High Teacher of the Year in 1991; selected as a Finalist for an Oklahoma Medal for Excellence in Teaching in 1991; chosen as News Channel 2 Teacher of the Week in May 1992; listed in "Who's Who Among America's Teachers" in 1990 and 1996; recognized at Teacher Recognition Day in 1994, 1995, 1997, 1998, and 1999; designated as "Most Influential Teacher" by the Oklahoma Foundation for Excellence for 1990-1999; and nominated for the Oklahoma Medal for Excellence in Teaching in 1999; and

WHEREAS, Linda L. Batty has demonstrated mastery of contemporary communications through use of virtual tours with classes, utilization of PowerPoint presentations for class and public meetings; use of the Internet; and constant computer activities for research and reference purposes at school and at home; and

WHEREAS, Linda L. Batty has participated in the Claremore community as a member of the Claremore Community Chorus; a member of the Afghanistan Perceivers; and as Vice President of the Claremore Toastmasters Club; and

WHEREAS, Linda L. Batty, after 33 years of teaching experience, will be joining the private sector to better pursue her personal goals.
