RESOLUTION 27

AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution requiring the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs to hire certain officers; making appropriations; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma is experiencing an aging population of state war veterans; and

WHEREAS, many of these veterans are or will be in need of more help to file for state and federal benefits; and

WHEREAS, Veteran Service Officers are qualified to help war veterans file for state and federal benefits and properly assist aging war veterans; and

WHEREAS, presently the number of Veteran Service Officers is not perceived to be enough to properly file for state and federal benefits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs hire an additional six (6) Veteran Service Officers to meet the needs of the aging veteran population.

THAT there be appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs a sum necessary to provide for the hiring of these additional officers.

THAT the Secretary of State distribute copies of this resolution to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs.
