SENATE JOINT  
RESOLUTION 47

AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution amending 63 O.S. 1991, Section 1-107, which relates to public health and safety; clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma will receive Two Billion Dollars (\$2,000,000,000.00) pursuant to the provisions of the Tobacco Settlement; and

WHEREAS, proposals for spending the settlement funds include funding of pre- and after-school care for children, early childhood education, anti-smoking and violence prevention initiatives, and health care for adults, the elderly and disabled.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 1991, Section 1-107, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-107. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund to be known as the Public Health Special Fund. All monies, fees and revenues collected, authorized or received from any source by the State Commissioner of Health or the State Department of Health under the provisions of ~~this~~ the Oklahoma Public Health Code or any other law or any agreement shall, unless otherwise expressly provided in this Code or other law, be placed in ~~said~~ such fund. ~~Said~~ The fund shall be a continuing fund not subject to fiscal year limitations. All monies accruing to the credit of ~~said~~ the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Commissioner for the purpose of maintaining and operating the

State Department of Health, and in administering and executing the laws pertaining to the duties and functions of the State Department of Health. Expenditures from ~~said~~ the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2000.
