AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution commending Jerrod Summers for winning Purcell's first-ever state wrestling championship; congratulating Purcell High School for its outstanding wrestling program; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, freshman Jerrod Summers, at 103 pounds, led the Purcell High School Dragon's wrestling team to an eleventh place finish with 27 points at the State Class 2A wrestling tournament at the State Fairgrounds Arena; and

WHEREAS, Jerrod Summers won the 103-pound bracket, becoming Purcell High School's first-ever state champion wrestler with a pin and decisions of 5-4 and 4-3; and

WHEREAS, Jerrod Summers came from behind in his last five matches to win in the third period ending his season with a 27-8 record; and

WHEREAS, Jerrod Summers wrestled at Noble and Lexington before coming to Purcell. Purcell High School had never scored a point in the state high school wrestling tournament until this year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
