AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution praising the Owasso Rams high school boys' baseball team; congratulating them for winning the Class 6A state baseball title; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Owasso Rams high school boys' baseball team has established a tradition of winning through the loser's bracket after being defeated in the first round of state high school baseball tournaments. Their victories in this year's tournament were the 10th and 11th straight over three years while facing elimination from the state tournament; and

WHEREAS, more than 2,400 fans packed J.L. Johnson Stadium at Oral Roberts University in Tulsa to watch a classic baseball game of epic proportions as the lead switched hands between the Sapulpa Chieftains and the Owasso Rams until the Rams won 4-3 in the ninth inning, giving them their second consecutive Class 6A state championship; and

WHEREAS, the Owasso Rams high school boys' baseball team not only won a second title but also finished with a 122-13 record for the past three seasons: 38-5 in 1997, 45-3 in 1998 and 39-5 in 1999.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate praises the Owasso Rams boys' high school baseball team.

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates the Owasso Rams high school boys' baseball team for winning the Class 6A state title.
