AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution commending Sunset Elementary School for its excellence in education and praising the accomplishments of the Sunset Elementary students; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, The Institute for Academic Excellence recognizes schools throughout the country that exemplify outstanding performance in reading education; and

WHEREAS, Sunset Elementary School's adoption of the reading renaissance methods has resulted in a measurable increase in student reading performance; and

WHEREAS, Sunset Elementary has been awarded the distinguished Model School Certification for two consecutive years; and

WHEREAS, Sunset is one of only nine schools in the State of Oklahoma and one of two hundred and six schools in the United States to achieve this certification; and

WHEREAS, Sunset has one Model Library and twenty-four Model Classroom certifications for the 1999-2000 school year; and

WHEREAS, Sunset has one Master Library and twenty-one Master Classroom certifications for the 1999-2000 school year; and

WHEREAS, Sunset Elementary students read twenty-five thousand one hundred twenty-six books and passed a computer-based test with 89% accuracy during this period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
