I, Frank Keating, pursuant to the provisions of Section 23 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, hereby declare that an emergency exists in the State of Oklahoma by reason of a lack of adequate funding for programs vital to the continued economic, educational, and social development of Oklahomans, and for health and safety issues.

Having declared that emergency conditions exist, I request the Senate and House of Representatives to concur in this declaration of emergency and to appropriate Seventy-two Million Six Hundred Forty-three Thousand Six Hundred Twelve Dollars (\$72,643,612.00) from the Constitutional Reserve Fund for the following purposes in the following amounts:

1. To the Department of Transportation for construction of roads in the sum of up to Seventy Million Six Hundred Forty-three Thousand Six Hundred Twelve Dollars (\$70,643,612.00).
2. To the Oklahoma Water Resources Board for weather modification in the sum of up to One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00).
3. To the State Emergency Fund created pursuant to Section 139.42 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes for state emergencies in the sum of up to One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00).
