AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, lines 7 through 9, restore the stricken title to read

"An Act relating to counties and county officers; amending 19 O.S. 1991, Section 744, which relates to use of private prison contractors; authorizing certain contracts upon recommendation by County Jail Trust Authority; permitting contracts to be for certain time period; requiring specified person to report on implementation of certain contract; providing for certain immunity for board of county commissioners, county sheriff and County Jail Trust Authority; stating that certain contract contain specified provisions; requiring certain notice of termination of contract; prohibiting impairment of certain contracts; providing exception; amending Section 2, Chapter 237, O.S.L. 1994 (19 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 904.2), which relates to board of directors for County Jail Trust Authority; modifying membership of County Jail Trust Authority; inserting gender-neutral language; and providing an effective date."

AMENDMENT NO. 2 Page 5, Section 1, line 26, after the word "a" and before the word "written" delete the words "thirty-day" and insert the words "sixty-day"

AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 6, Section 2, line 17, after the inserted comma and before the word "the" insert the words "one member appointed by"

AMENDMENT NO. 4. Page 6, Section 3, line 32, after the word "effective" and before the figure "1" delete the word "November" and insert the word "July"

and on line 32 1/2 insert a new Section 4 to read

"SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval."

and amend title accordingly
