An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2001, Sections 4-120.3, 14-108 and 14-113.2, which relate to cancellation of registration of deceased persons and the return of absentee ballots; deleting obsolete language; providing for next of kin of certain persons to cancel voter registration at certain places; requiring certain persons to notarize absentee ballots at no charge; authorizing the use of a private mail service to return absentee ballots under specified conditions; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, line 27, after the word "voter" and before the word "be" strike the word "may" and insert the word "shall"

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 3, line 2 1/2, add a new Section 4 to read

"SECTION 4. If a congressional redistricting plan has not been enacted by the sine die deadline, May 31, 2002, the State of Oklahoma shall contain five at-large Congressional Districts. The five Congressional Districts shall consist of every Tract, Block Group, Block, Place and Voting Tabulation District (VTD) as defined in 2000 by the United States Bureau of the Census."
