AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, lines 7 through 8, restore the title

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 1, line 10 1/2, insert a new Section 1 to read

"SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1220, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 1220. It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly
transport in any moving vehicle upon a public highway, street or
alley any intoxicating beverage or low-point beer, as defined by
Sections 163.1 and 163.2 of Title 37 of the Oklahoma Statutes, except
in the original container which shall not have been opened and from
which the original cap or seal shall not have been removed, unless
the opened container be in the rear trunk or rear compartment, which
shall include the spare tire compartment in a station wagon or panel
truck, or any outside compartment which is not accessible to the
driver or any other person in the vehicle while it is in motion. Any
person violating the provisions of this section shall be deemed
guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished by a
fine of not more than ~~Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)~~ One Hundred Dollars

(\$100.00) or by not more than forty (40) hours of community service,
or by both such fine and community service."
