AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and entire bill and insert

"An Act relating to public health and safety; creating the Oklahoma Medicaid Accountability and Outcomes Act; directing certain study and evaluation of the state Medicaid program under certain circumstances; requiring a report; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5007.1 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma Medicaid Accountability and Outcomes Act".

B. 1. Subject to the availability of funds, the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee for the Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall enter into a contract for a study of the state Medicaid program. The contract shall be executed with an organization having nationally recognized expertise in the area of health care and health care service delivery.

2. The study shall include the entire state Medicaid program,

but shall focus on Medicaid managed care programs and services delivered pursuant to the Oklahoma Medicaid Healthcare Options Act.

3. The purpose of the study shall be to evaluate access to care, health care outcomes, and the quality and cost of health care and related services delivered through the state Medicaid program.

4. A report of the study and findings shall be made to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority, the Governor, and the appropriate committees of the Oklahoma State Senate and the Oklahoma House of Representatives.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
