An Act relating to corrections; amending 57 O.S. 1991, Section 515, which relates to probation-parole officers; modifying language; requiring the Director of the Department of Corrections to determine duties and responsibilities of certain officers; authorizing the Department of Corrections to award the identification badge to certain retiring employees; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, Section 1, lines 17 and 18, after the word "by" on line 17 and before the second word "the" on line 18 delete the words "the Director of"

and amend title accordingly

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 1, Section 1, lines 18 through 22 after the word "shall" on line 18 delete the colon

and on line 19 delete the figure and word "1. Be" and insert the word "be"

and on line 20 after the word "officers" delete the semicolon and the word "and"

and on lines 21 and 22 delete all the language beginning with the number "2." on line 21 through the word "Director" on line 22

and amend the title accordingly

AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 2, line 16 1/2, add a new Section 2 to read

"SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be

codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

Upon the effective date of this act, fugitive apprehension officers employed by the Department of Corrections shall be awarded an annualized increase equal to the amount of increase awarded to other commissioned officers of the Department of Corrections on

October 1, 1994, exclusive of longevity pay or shift differential pay.

Upon the effective date of this act, fugitive apprehension officers who were employed by the Department of Corrections on October 1, 1994, shall receive back pay for the period beginning with the month of October, 1994, and ending with the month this act becomes effective."
