ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 879

An Act relating to the Corporation Commission;
prohibiting the Corporation Commission from issuing
order or rule requiring specific labeling of motor
fuel containing ethyl alcohol sold by certain retail
establishments; providing for codification; and
declaring an emergency.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause and entire bill
and insert

"An Act relating to the Corporation Commission;
providing for the posting of motor fuel additives
information at retail facilities; requiring certain
labeling of motor fuel sold at certain airports for
fueling aircraft; directing the Corporation
Commission to promulgate rules; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in
the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 620 of Title 17, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Except as otherwise provided in this section, retail facilities
that sell motor fuel shall not be required to post information
regarding fuel additives on the motor fuel dispenser or anywhere else
on the premises of the facilities. Motor fuel sold at regional or
smaller airports in the state for fueling aircraft shall be labeled

with the percent of alcohol, if any, in the fuel. The Corporation Commission shall promulgate rules consistent with the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2003."
