AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, strike the stricken title, enacting
clause and entire bill and insert

"An Act relating to various state agencies; amending
Section 8, Chapter 412, O.S.L. 2000; modifying budget
limits for the Supreme Court; amending Section 5,
Chapter 413, O.S.L. 2000; modifying budget limits for
the District Attorneys Council; directing the Office of
State Finance to transfer funds to the Volunteer
Firefighter Employer Contribution Payment Revolving
Fund; exempting sections of Enrolled House Bill No.
1564 of the 1st Session of the 48th Oklahoma
Legislature from budgetary and employee limitations
otherwise imposed upon agencies by law; and declaring
an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 8, Chapter 412, O.S.L. 2000 is
amended to read as follows:

Section 8. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, the
Supreme Court shall budget all funds appropriated or otherwise made
available for the operation of the district courts in the following
categories and amounts:

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 5, Chapter 413, O.S.L.
2000, is amended to read as follows:

Section 5. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, the District Attorneys Council shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for each budget category.

SECTION 3. TRANSFER The Director of the Office of State Finance on the effective date of this act shall transfer to the Volunteer Firefighter Employer Contribution Payment Revolving Fund any funds appropriated for making payments to the Oklahoma Firefighters Pension and Retirement System.

SECTION 4. Budgetary and employee limitations otherwise imposed upon agencies by law shall not apply to expenditures by state agencies made from appropriations received pursuant to Sections 11, 12, 20, 21, 22, 29, 33, 34, 35, 45, 51, 80, 83, 89, 90, 93, 96, 97, 102, 103, 105, 107, 110, 111, 117, 130, 133, 134, 139, 144 and 166 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1564 of the 1st Session of the 48th Oklahoma Legislature.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
