AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, strike the stricken title, enacting clause
and entire bill and insert

"[health maintenance organizations - Insurance
Department - noncodification -
emergency]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

A. 1. The State Commissioner of Health is hereby directed to
review the evidence of coverage, or any other appropriate
documentation, of all health maintenance organizations and other
managed care plans which are licensed, certified, registered or in
any way regulated by the State Department of Health to determine
which preventive medical services are included as covered services
by such health maintenance organizations and other managed care
plans.

2. The Insurance Commissioner is hereby directed to review the
evidence of coverage, or any other appropriate documentation, of all
health insurers that are licensed or in any way regulated by the
Insurance Department to determine which preventive medical services
are included as covered services by such insurers.

3. The Oklahoma State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board (OSEEGIB) is hereby directed to review the evidence of coverage, or any other appropriate documentation, of all OSEEGIB health insurance plans available to state employees to determine which preventive medical services are included as covered services by such plans.

B. On or before January 1, 2003, the State Commissioner of Health, the Insurance Commissioner and the Administrator of OSEEGIB shall each submit a written report of findings pursuant to the provisions of subsection A of this section to the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and Speaker of the House of Representatives.

C. As used in this section, "preventive medical services" means those services and procedures which are designed primarily to prevent, rather than to treat, particular injuries, diseases, illnesses or conditions.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
