An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 1991, Sections 151, 156.4, 159.9 and 159.10, which relate to state-owned vehicles; authorizing Department of Public Safety to designate patrol units in certain manner; authorizing certain agencies to have unmarked cars for undercover use; modifying reference; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Sections 78 and 78a, which relate to fleet management and purchase of vehicles by Central Services; modifying references; specifying duties for certain individuals; modifying information to be provided by agencies under certain circumstances; repealing 47 O.S. 1991, Sections 152, 159.1, 159.3, 159.4, 159.5, 159.6 and 159.8, which relate to state-owned automobiles; providing for recodification; and providing an effective date.
