entitled

An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety; amending 47 O.S. 1991, Section 2-105, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2000 (47 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 2-105), which relates to qualifications for Highway Patrolman; modifying maximum age for certain purposes; amending 47 O.S. 1991, Section 2-105.4, as last amended by Section 10, Chapter 37, O.S.L. 2000, (47 O.S. Supp. 2000, Section 2-105.4), which relates to Highway Patrol salaries; modifying salaries; establishing new rank; establishing stipend to be paid to certain employees; requiring prior service to be counted for certain purpose; establishing criteria for pay increases; amending Section 6, Chapter 245, O.S.L. 1998, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 195, O.S.L. 2000 and Section 7, Chapter 245, O.S.L. 1998, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2000 (47 O.S. Supp. 2000, Sections 2-105.6 and 2-105.7), which relate to salaries for Lake Patrol and Capitol Patrol; modifying salaries; creating new positions; prohibiting promotions to certain position; establishing criteria for pay increases; establishing a monthly bonus pay for persons with certain levels of education; requiring retroactive pay for certain persons; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
